- First pod height among the highest of the registration variety lists in Belgium and France, contributing to a more efficient harvest
- High & stable yield
- Excellent pod shattering tolerance
- Brown hilum
- Suited for feed
- Suited for organic agriculture

SOWING ADVICE

- Sowing end of April, early May
- Sow depth: 2-3 cm
- Sowing density: 65-75 seeds per m²
- Distance between rows: 12.5-50 cm
- Plant in warm soils (>10°C) with warm temperatures during the days after sowing
